### UPCOMING PROJECT NOTIFICATION

November 14, 2022

Dear Neighbor:

As part of our commitment to provide safe, reliable service to our customers, Central Maine Power Company (CMP) will be replacing transmission line structures in your area beginning next year to meet capacity and reliability needs due to increased energy usage.

CMP's Section 80 115kV transmission line travels approximately 22 miles from Coopers Mills Substation in Windsor to Highland Substation in Warren, traversing Windsor, Jefferson, Washington, Waldoboro, and Warren. A new line will be constructed in the existing right of way offset from the current line and will be built using a taller monopole (single) structure made of weathered brown light duty steel plus other components.

CMP crews will be accessing our transmission line corridor via roads where CMP has access rights or legal agreements with property owners or towns. Beginning this month, CMP land agents from our Energy Land Management department will be reaching out to some adjacent landowners to acquire access rights or discuss the right of way for this project.

You may see people in our corridor evaluating the structures or taking pictures with cameras or drones. This work is being completed to prepare for our construction start which is anticipated to be summer 2023. CMP is undertaking a permitting process to either update permits that were issued a couple years ago or to acquire new ones. They include: the Maine Public Utilities Commission, which in June 2022 approved a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the rebuild citing capacity needs and reliability standards; the Maine Department of Environmental Protection; the Maine Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife; and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. CMP, too, will be meeting with each municipality regarding permit needs and to share information about the upcoming project's construction schedule.
